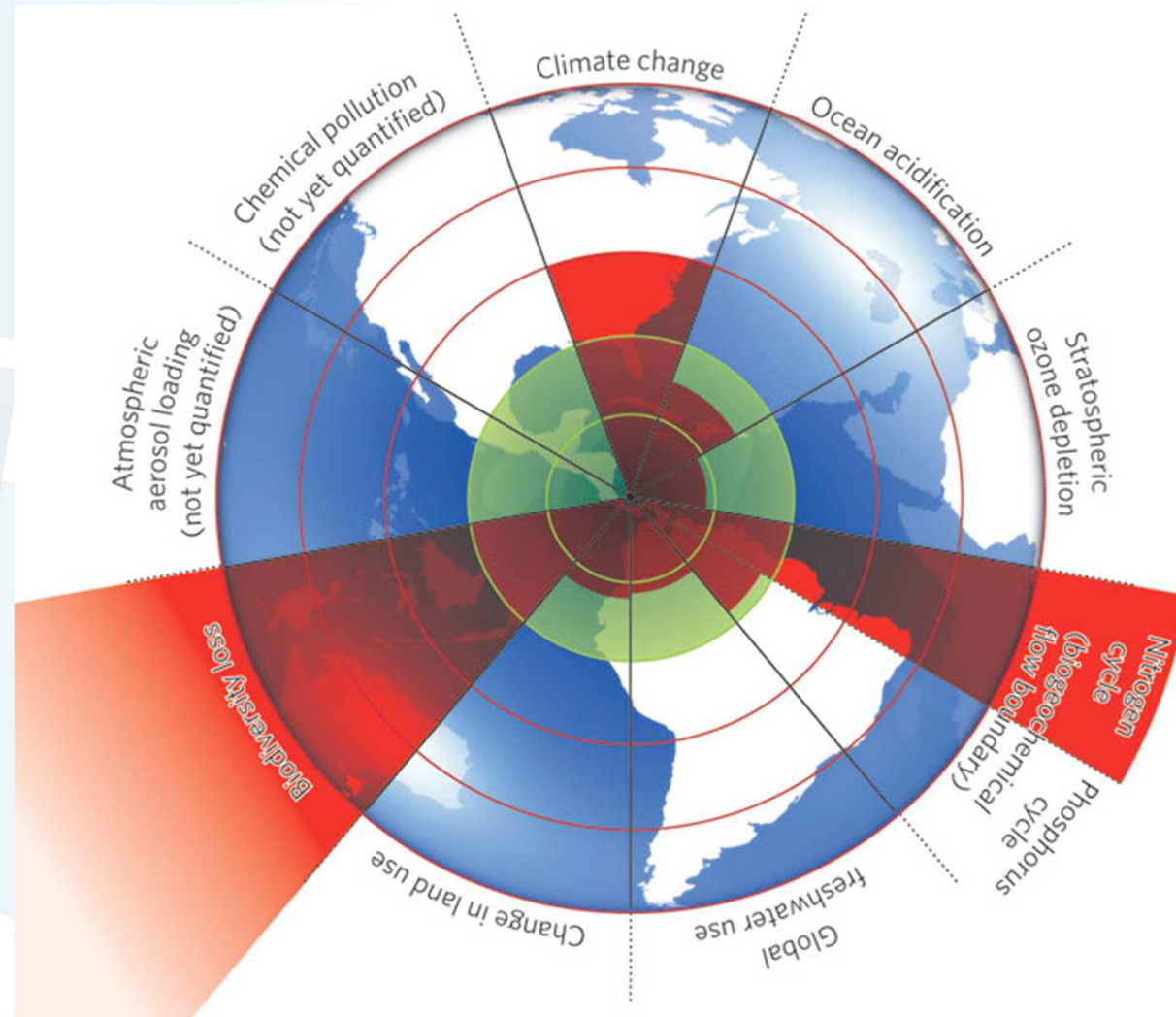

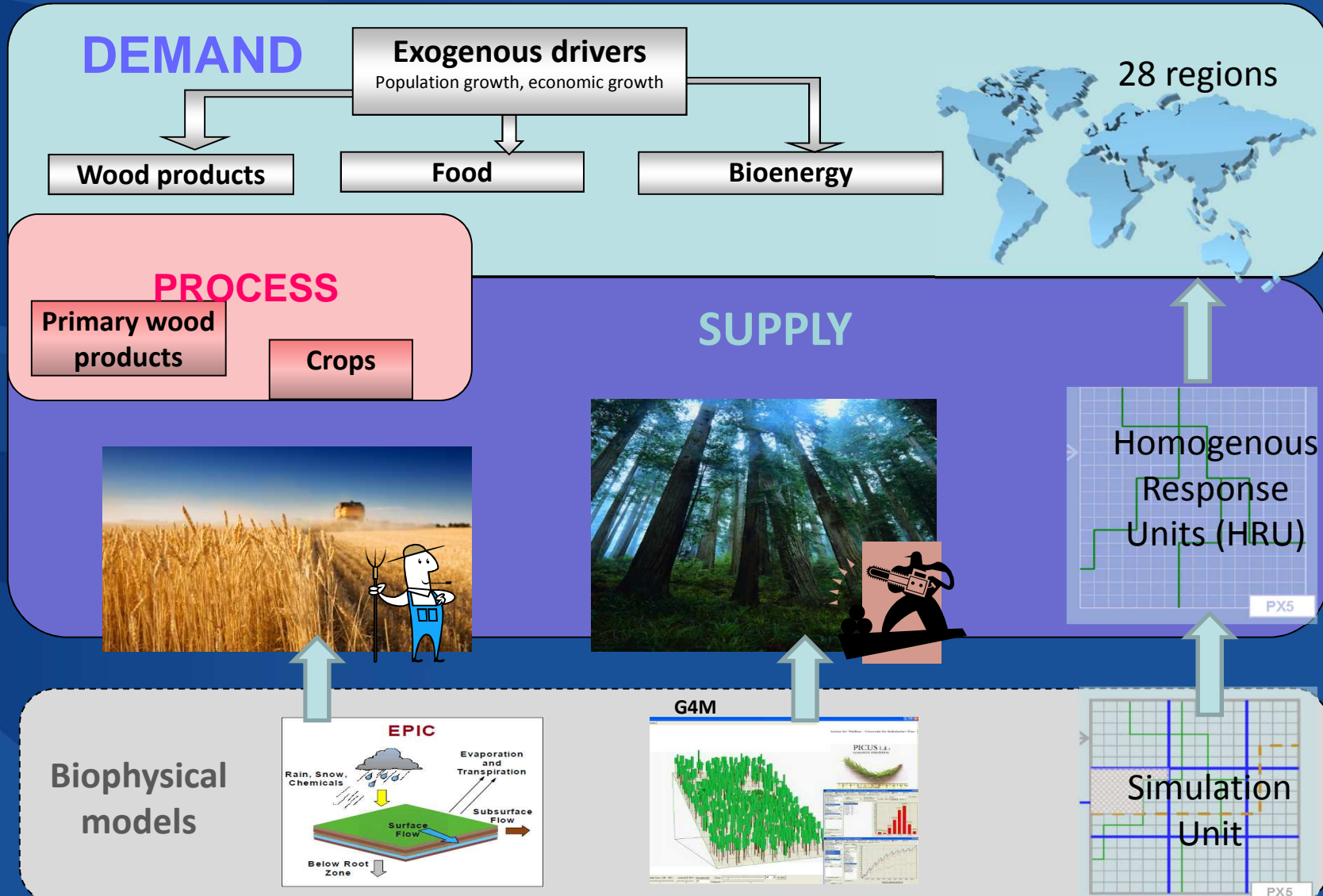

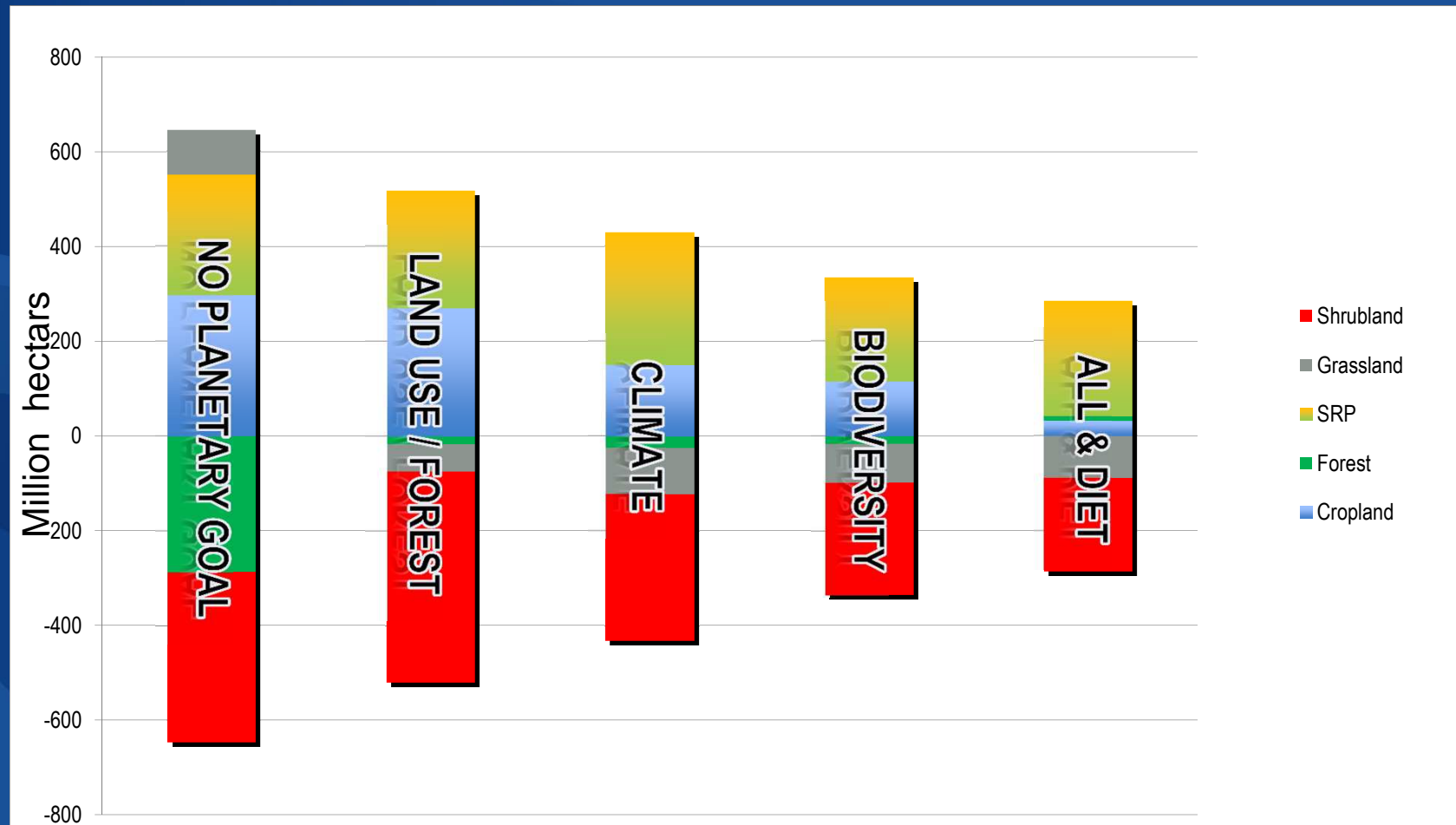
Managing Planetary Boundaries



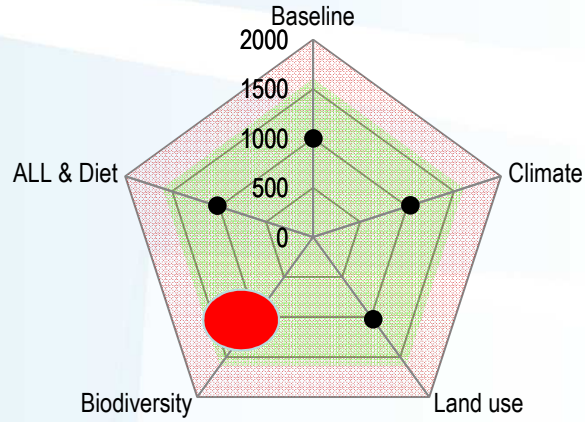
GLOal BIOSphere Management Model



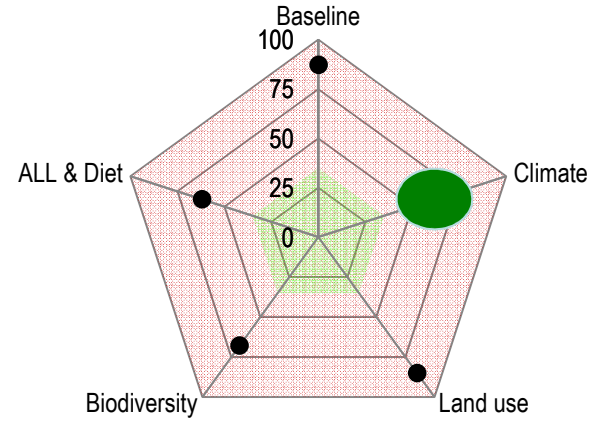
2050 - Planetary Goals and Land Use



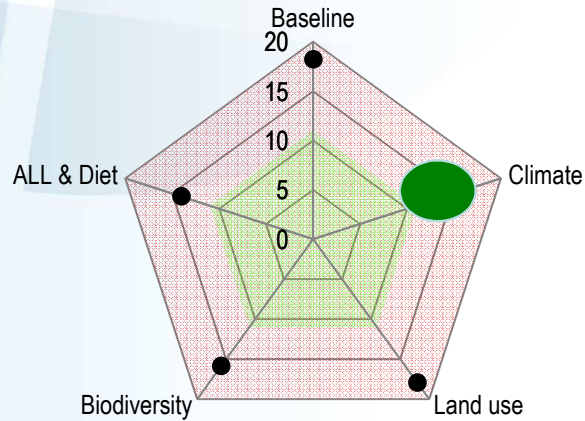
Water use (km³/yr)



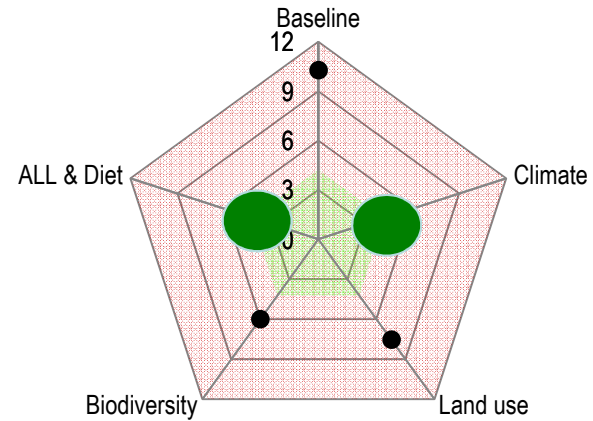
Nitrogen fixation (Mt/yr)



Phosphorus use (Mt/yr)



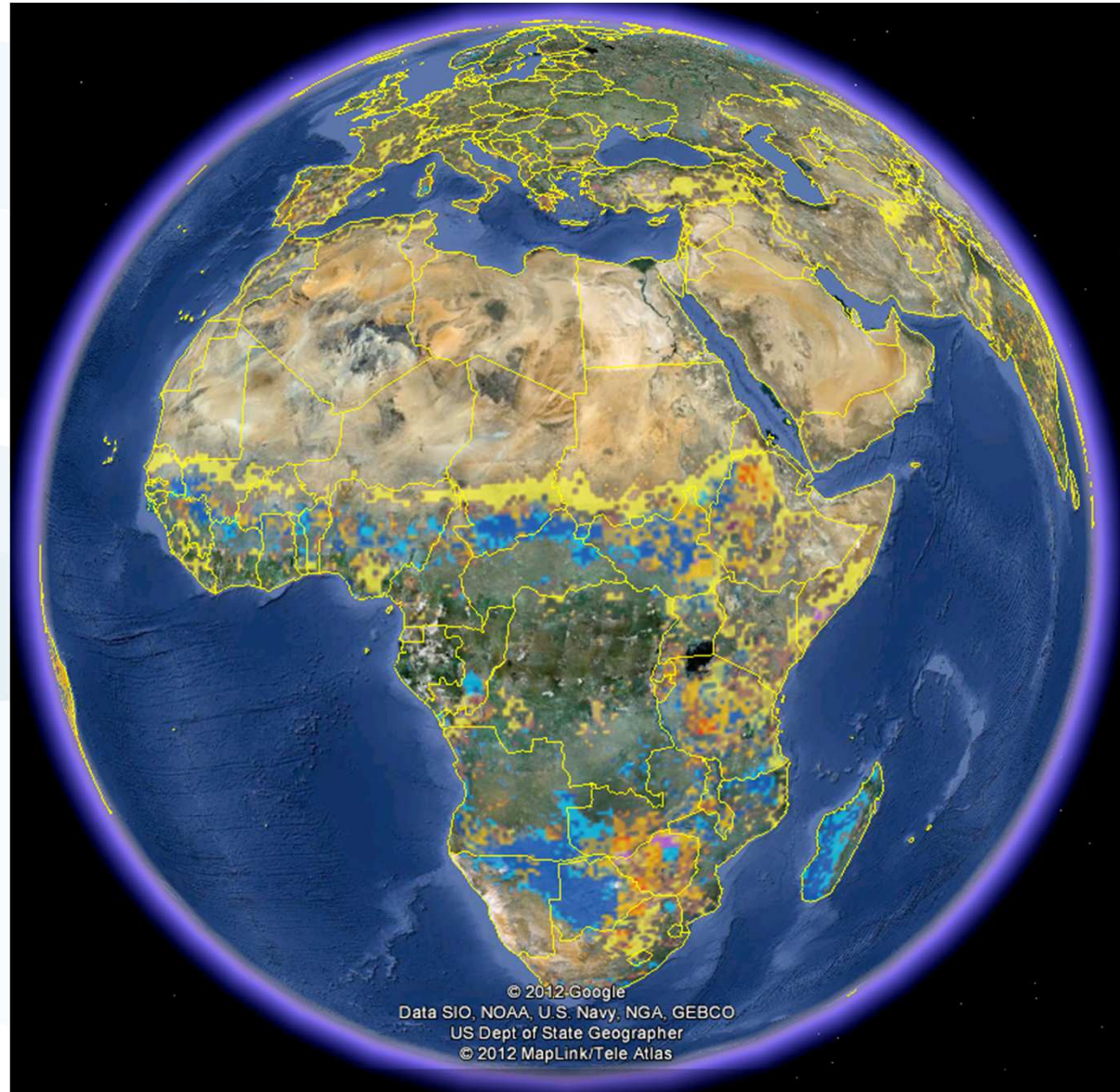
GHG emissions (GtCO₂/yr)
